

A Special Meeting of the Peru Town Board was held on Wednesday, October 14, at the Peru Town Hall. Those present were Mr. Cortland Forrence, Deputy Supervisor; Mr. Tom Powers, Councilman; Mr. Brandy McDonald, Councilman; Mr. Pete Glushko, Councilman; Mr. Greg Timmons, Water/Sewer Superintendent; Mr. Mike Farrell, Highway Superintendent; and Mrs. Kathleen Flynn, Town Clerk.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mr. Forrence, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Discussion- Approval of Water Quality Improvement Projects Grant Application for the SolarBee Aeration System.

Mr. Powers referred to information that he had in his possession, and also to a telephone conversation that he had with a representative from SolarBee. Mr. Powers informs members that he believes that this system would not be beneficial for the Town Of Peru, because it is a circulatory system and not an aeroator. Mr. McDonald asks Mr. Powers if he would be willing to share the information. Mr. Powers agrees to provide the information to the other councilors.

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to create a four way stop intersection at the intersection of the Military Turnpike and Brand Hollow Road pursuant to its authority under Vehicle and Traffic Law 1660; and

WHEREAS, Stop signs are currently in place on Brand Hollow Road, controlling both lanes and directions of travel, at its intersection with the Military Turnpike; it is now

RESOLVED AND ORDERED, That the Town Highway Superintendent erect or cause to be erected stop signs controlling both lanes and directions of travel on the Military Turnpike at its intersection with Brand Hollow Road; and it is further

RESOLVED AND ORDERED, That the Town Highway Superintendent erect or cause to be erected any other signage necessary to advise traffic that the intersection of the Military Turnpike and Brand Hollow Road is controlled by a four way stop.
